1 Introduction

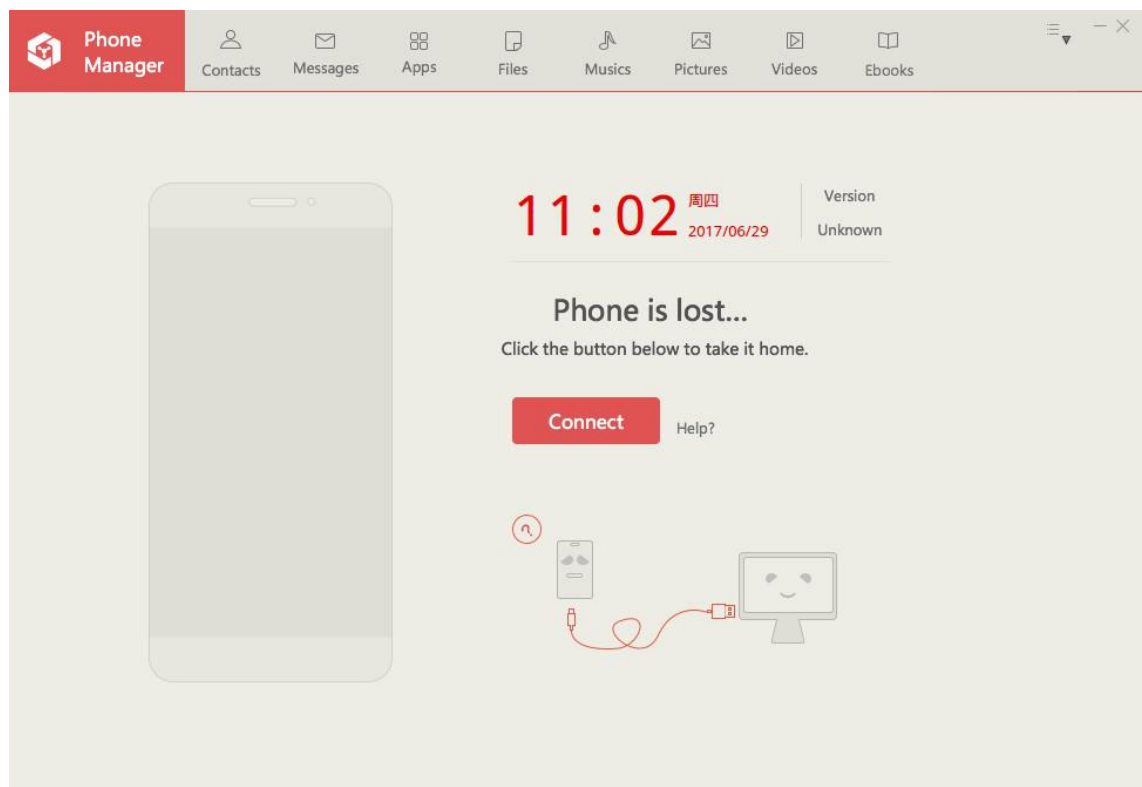
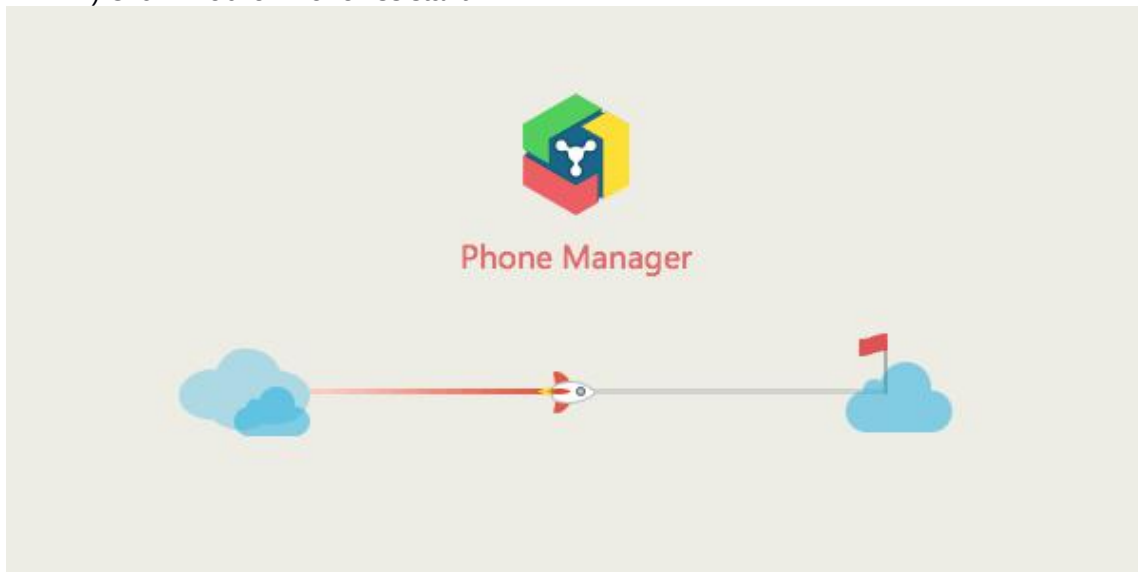
Phone Manager is a cdos mobile assistant for Android phone.

Phone Manager can manage phone's information, SMS messages, contacts, applications, files, photos, musics, videos, ebooks, etc. You can get phone's RAM, sdcard information, receive/send SMS, install/uninstall application, export/import files, photos, videos, musics, ebooks and soon.

2 Function

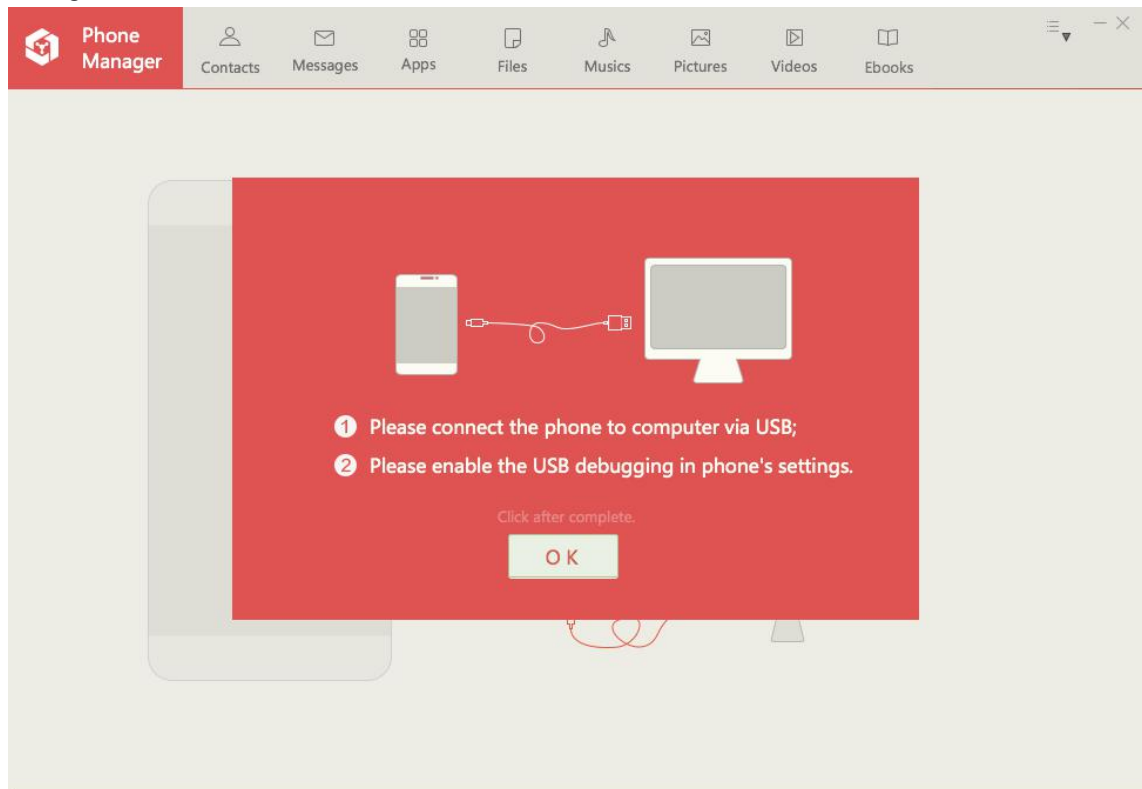
2.1 Run Phone Manager

- 1) Click “Start” menu;
- 2) Click “All Programs”;
- 3) Click “Accessories”;
- 4) Click “Mobile PhoneAssistant”.



First, you must connect your mobile phone with PC through USB cable. Then you can click “connect” button to connect your mobile phone. If connect phone failed, you will get follow

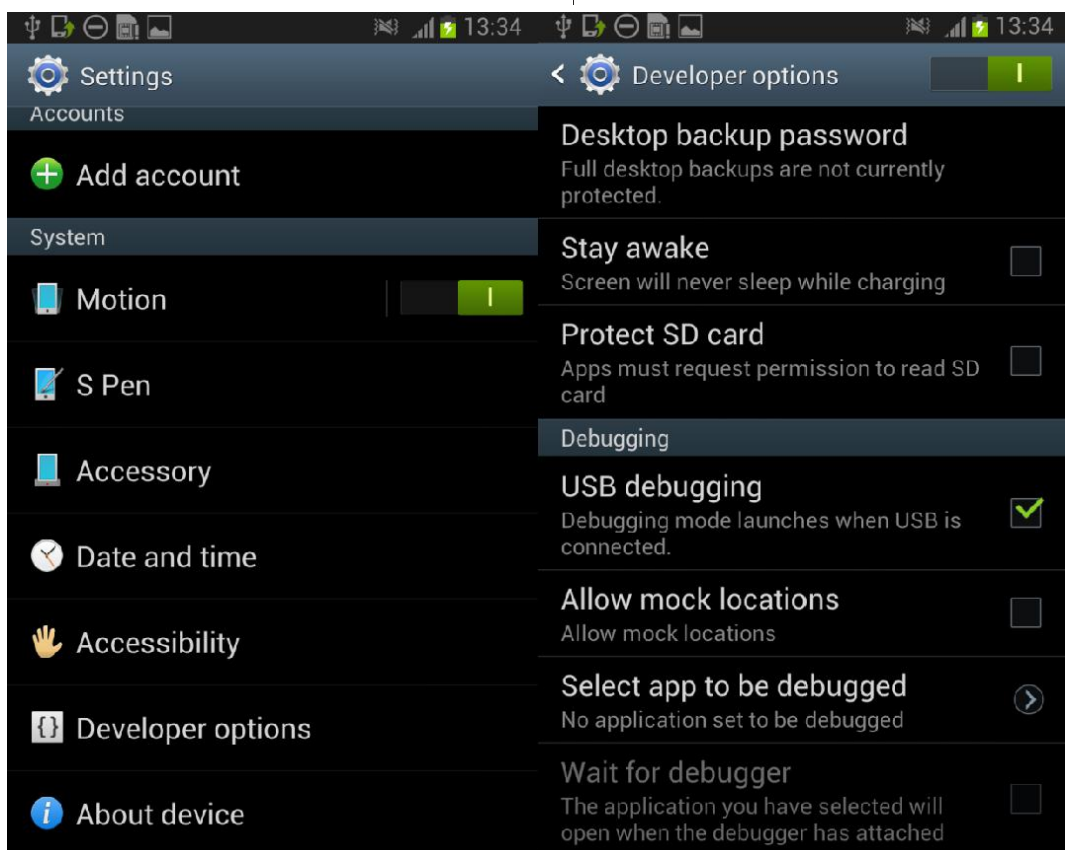
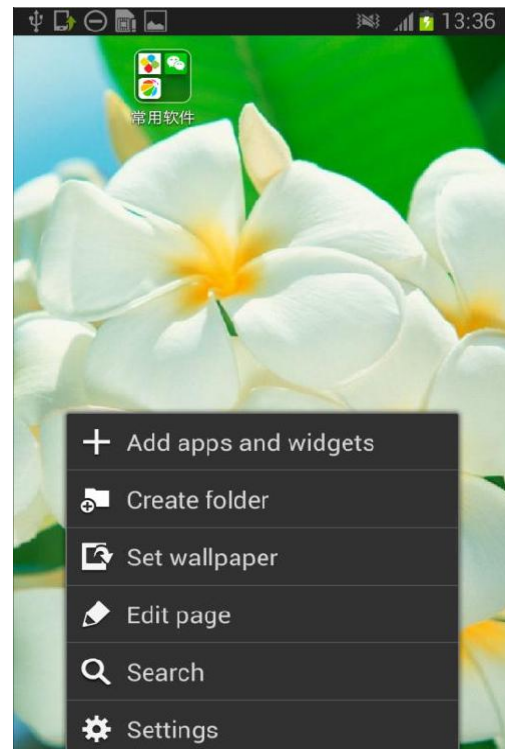
You must make sure your mobile phone(Android) has enabled USB debugging, and the USB cable is in good contact. Enable Android USB debugging method:

- 1) Power on your Android phone;
- 2) Launch "Setting" application;
- 3) Click "Developer options";
- 4) Enable "USB debugging".

Take Samsung mobile phones as an example:

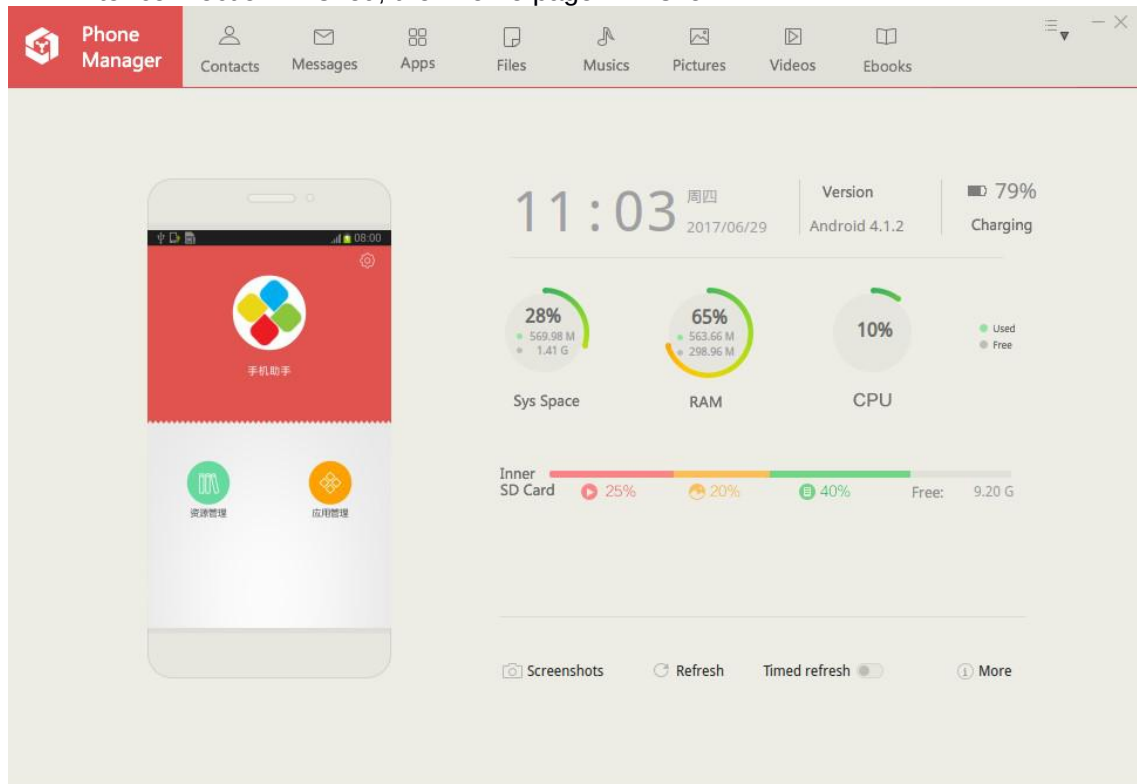


After enable “USB debugging” in “Developer options”, click “connect” button to finish connect to your phone.

Your phone might prompt the installation of “Phone Manager” apk. Please click yes to finish installation and connection.

1. Home page

After connection finished, the “Home page” will show.

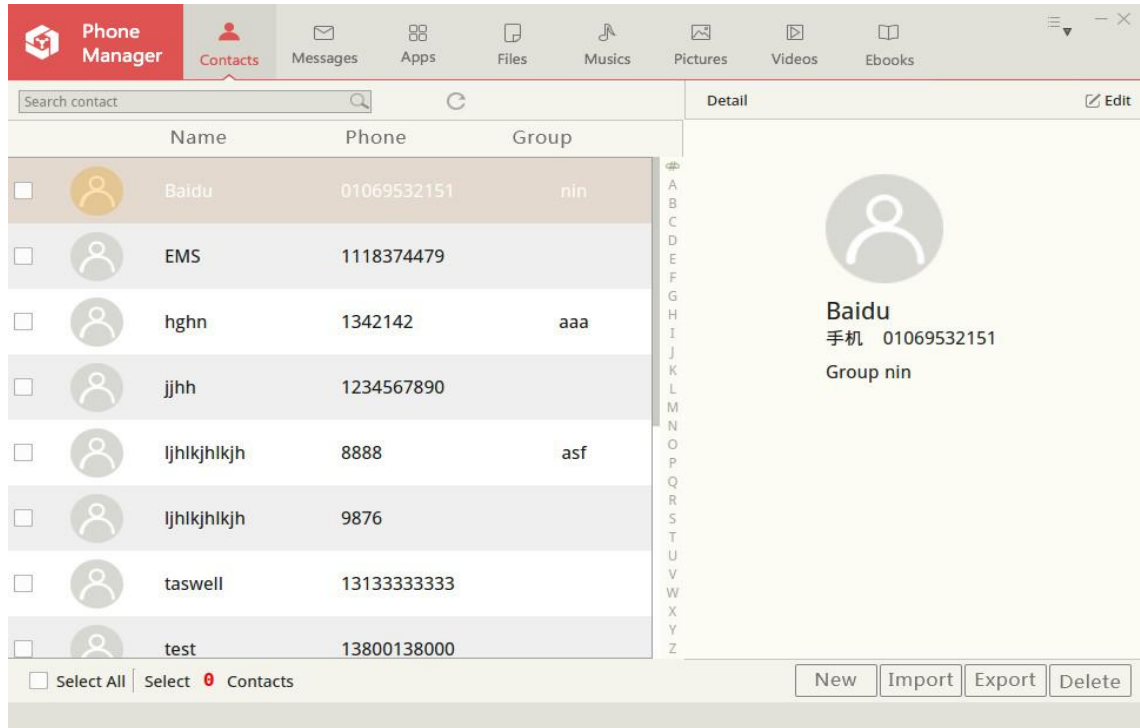


The home page shows the mobile phone's screenshots, system version, power and other mobile phone information, as well as system space, memory, CPU occupancy and so on. Screenshot area will real-time display the mobile phone's screenshot if enable “Timed refresh”. You can click “Refresh” button to refresh information and screenshot manually. Save current screenshot though click “Screenshots” button.

Click on the upper column of "Contacts", "Messages", "Apps", "Files", "Musics", "Pictures", "Videos", "Ebooks", into the management page of "Contacts", "Messages", "Apps", "Files", "Musics", "Pictures", "Videos", "Ebooks".

2. Contacts page

The contact page displays the list of all contacts in your mobile phone address book. You can do new, delete, modify, import, export and other operations to the contacts.



1) New contact

Click the “New” button, and fill out the contact name, number and other contacts in the pop-up dialog.

2) Delete contact

Select the contacts, and then click the “Delete” button to delete the selected contacts.

3) Modify contact

(1) Choose the contact;

(2) Click the “Edit” button in the upper right corner; (3)

Modify the contact information in the pop-up dialog box; (4)

Click the “Save” button.

4) Refresh contact list

Click “Refresh” button to refresh the contact list.

5) Export contact

Select the contacts, and then click the “Export” button to export the selected contacts.

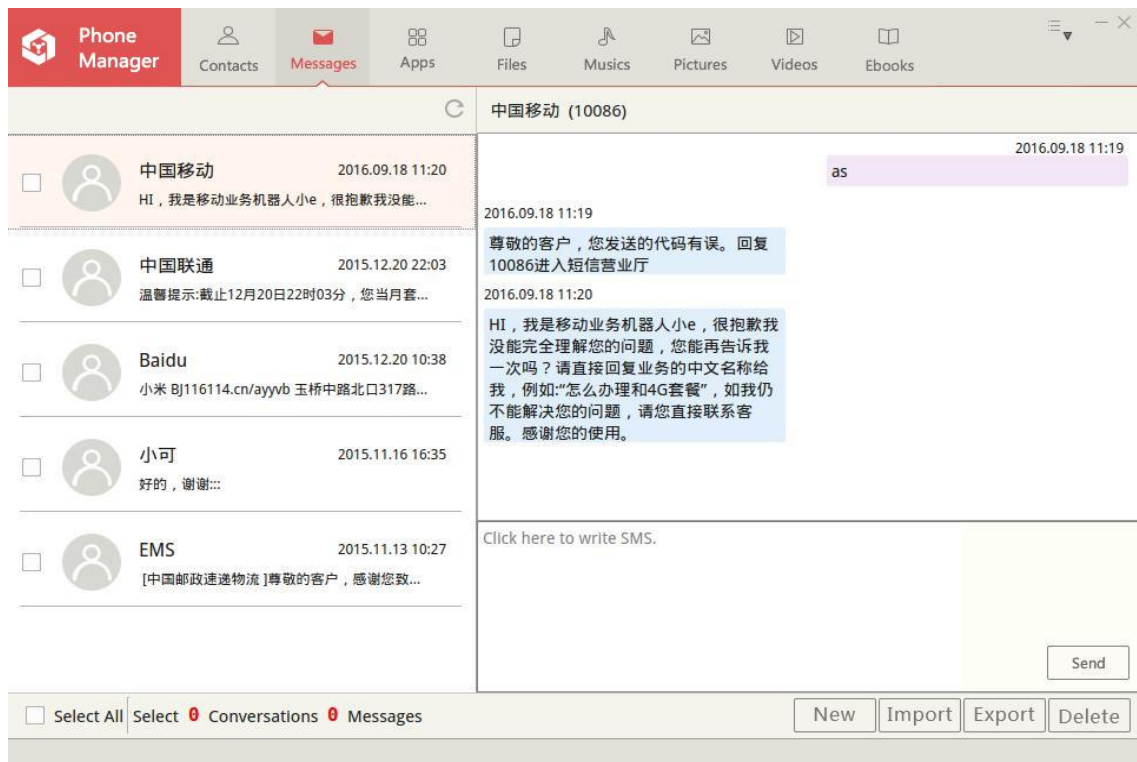
6) Import contact

(1) Click the “Import” button;

(2) Select the backup contact file.

3. Messages page

Messages page can display all your messages. The phone will prompt the "Phone Manager try to read messages permission" at the first time to launch "Phone Manager" apk. You need to click "allow" button. Messages are sorted by the time of receipt. You can do new, modify, delete and other operations.



1) New message & Send

- (1) Click the "New" button;
- (2) Edit new message;
- (3) Click the "Send" button.

2) Backup message

- (1) Select conversations;
- (2) Click the "Export" button.

3) Import message

- (1) Click the "Import" button;
- (2) Select the backup message file.

4) Delete message

Select conversations, and then click the "Delete" button.

5) Refresh message list

Click "Refresh" button to refresh the message list.

4. Apps page

Apps page shows all applications on your phone. Application's information contains name, version, size, APK name. The application's detail information will be displayed on the right side.

1) Uninstall application

Select application, and then click the "Uninstall" button.

2) Copy application to PC

Click the "Copy to PC" button (Or select the application, and then click the "Export" button), the selected application will be saved.

Notice: Only application's owner is "user" can be exported.

3) Install application

- (1) Click the "Install" button;
- (2) Select APK file on your PC.

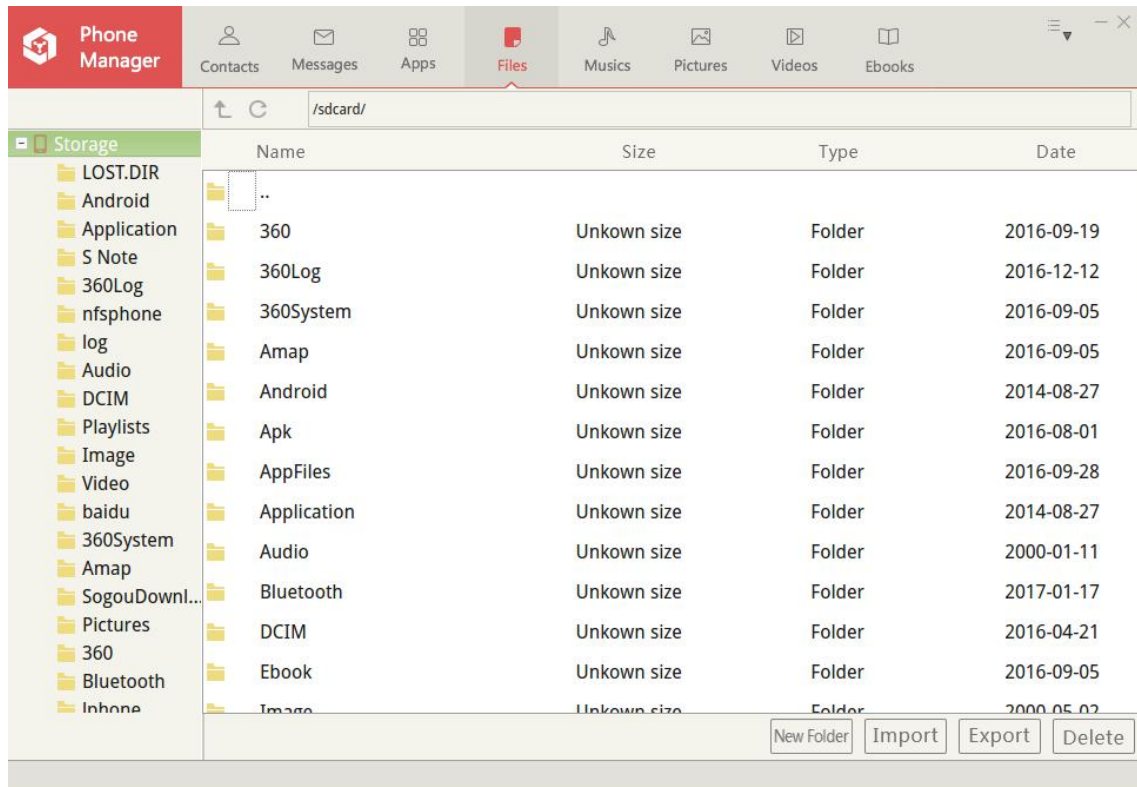
4) Refresh application list

Click "Refresh" button to refresh the application list.

5. Files page

Files page shows the file list on your phone. You can do new, refresh, delete on your phone.

You can copy files from your computer to your phone or copy files from your phone to your computer also.



1) New folder

Click the "New Folder" button.

2) Copy files to phone

Click the "Import" button, and then select files on your computer.

3) Copy files to computer

Click the "Export" button, and then select path on your computer.

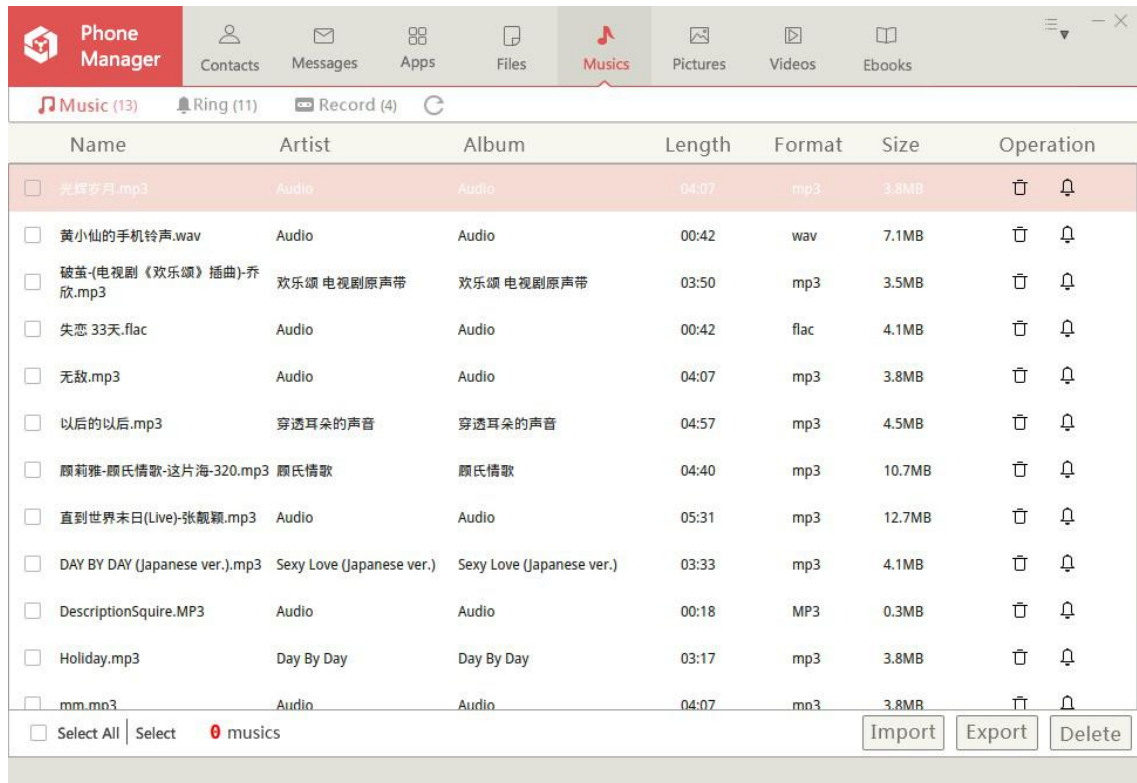
4) Delete

(1) Select file on your phone;

(2) Click the "Delete" button.

6. Musics page

Musics page shows music, ring, record list on your phone. You can play it with double click, you can copy musics from your computer to your phone or copy musics from your phone to your computer also.



1) Play music

Double click the music.

2) Import music

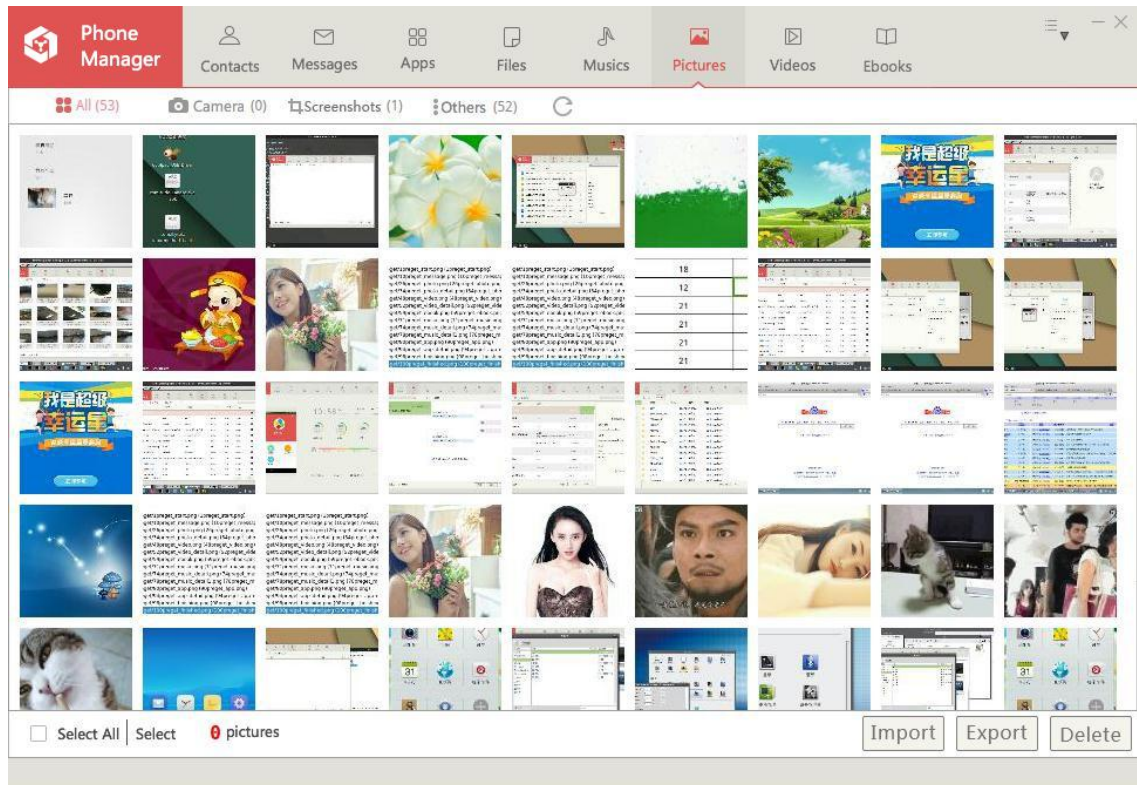
Click the "Import" button, and then select the music files on your computer.

3) Export music

- (1) Select musics;
- (2) Click the "Export" button;
- (3) Select export path.

7. Pictures page

Pictures page shows thumbnail images on the phone. Double click the thumbnail to browse the origin picture. You can copy pictures from your computer to your phone or copy pictures from your phone to your computer.



1) Browse origin picture

Double click the thumbnail.

2) Import picture

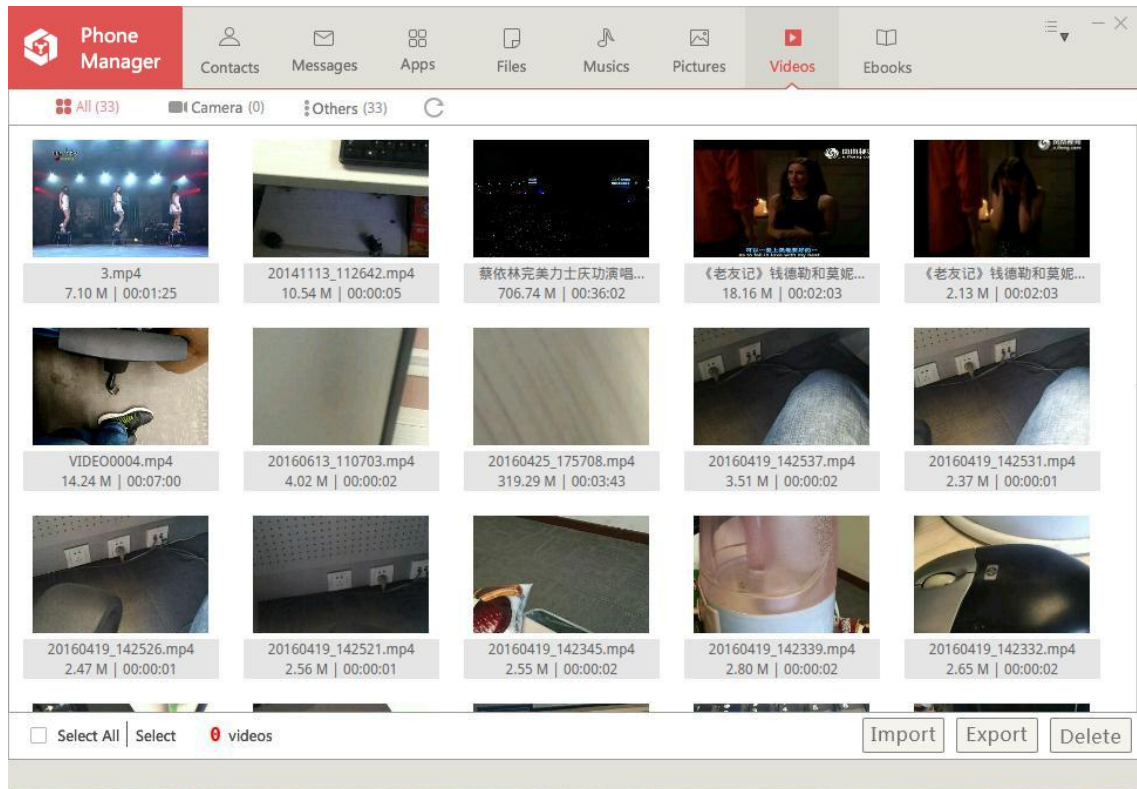
Click the “Import” button, and then select pictures on your computer.

3) Export picture

- (1) Select thumbnail images;
- (2) Click the “Export” button;
- (3) Select export path.

8. Videos page

Videos page shows video thumbnails on your phone. Double click the thumbnail to play video. You can copy videos from your computer to your phone or copy videos from your phone to your computer.



1) Play video

Double click the video thumbnail.

2) Import video

Click the “Import” button, and then select videos on your computer.

3) Export video

- (1) Select video thumbnails;
- (2) Click the “Export” button;
- (3) Select export path.

9. Ebooks page

Ebooks page shows e-book thumbnails on your phone. Double click the thumbnail to open it. You can copy e-books from your computer to your phone or copy e-books from your phone to your computer.



1) Open e-book

Double click the e-book thumbnail.

2) Import e-book

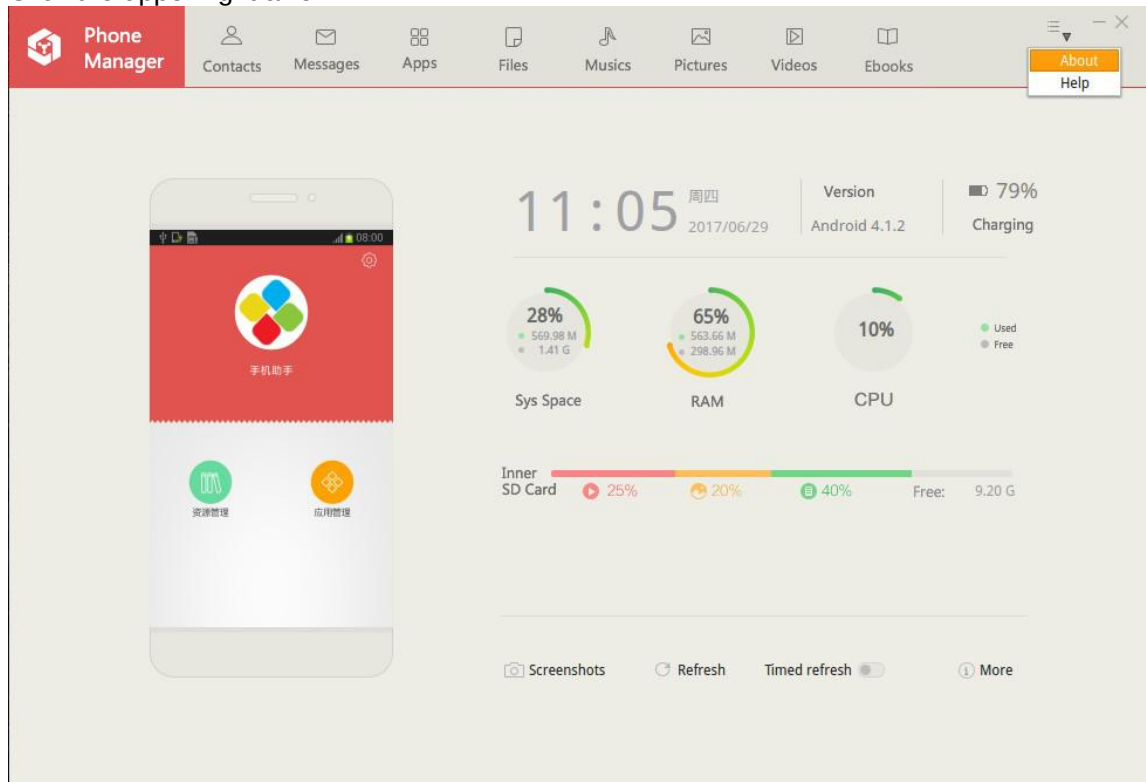
Click the “Import” button, and then select e-books on your computer.

3) Export e-book

- (1) Select e-book thumbnails;
- (2) Click the “Export” button;
- (3) Select export path.
